Dear YES Prep Families,

We hope this message finds you safe and well. By now, you may have heard the <u>Governor's announcement</u> earlier this week regarding masks. While in the future masks will not be required on campuses in accordance with the latest state mandate, out of an abundance of caution for the safety of students, staff and their families, we continue to encourage their use by those not fully vaccinated and will welcome students and staff to continue to wear them.

Our health partner, Legacy Community Health, has been offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible staff, students (note: the vast majority of our students are now eligible) and their families since March 8, 2021, and we expect many more will receive it in the coming weeks.
